

NHS OpenAthens is an identity and access management service, used by the NHS in England and Scotland to provide all eligible staff with access to online resources such as bibliographic databases, journals and books.

You can access NHSE elearning for healthcare which has a range of learning programmes, if you have registered with an NHS England or NHS Scotland OpenAthens provider.

Staff employed by private providers who work in an NHS setting are eligible for an OpenAthens account.
