Present yourself professionally, following your employer's uniform policy.



Develop your understanding of how you learn best and share this with your educator to help them best support your learning.



Make yourself aware of local policies and procedures relevant to your role and follow them. If anything is unclear, ask your supervisor/line manager for further guidance.



Develop your understanding of the roles of the various members of the multi-disciplinary team and how they each contribute to safe, effective, high-quality service delivery.



Have a proactive approach to shadowing, observations, and all learning opportunities to ensure you get the best experience possible to support your learning.



Learn about and engage in honest self-assessment and reflective practice to identify your strengths, gaps in your understanding, and areas for improvement. Share this with your educator to help them support your learning.



You may have concerns or queries; if so, raise them with your educator promptly or contact the department manager, Clinical Lead, or AHP Practice Education Facilitator. If you don't know, ASK!



Be proactive in building your professional network, especially with other apprentices. Your network will be a great support for you and your career growth during your apprenticeship and your developing career.
